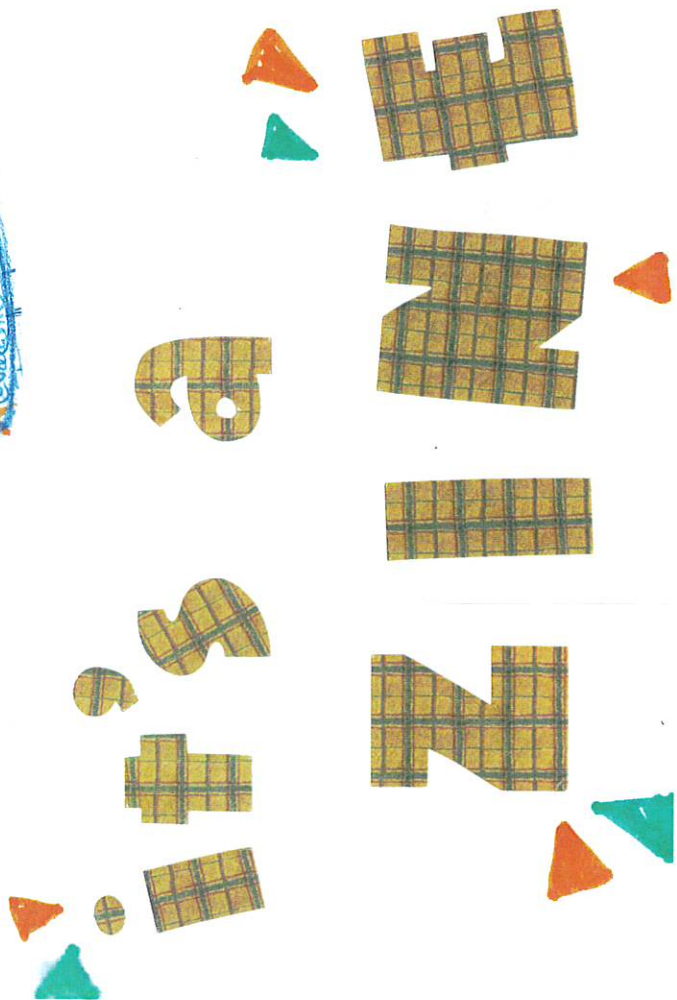

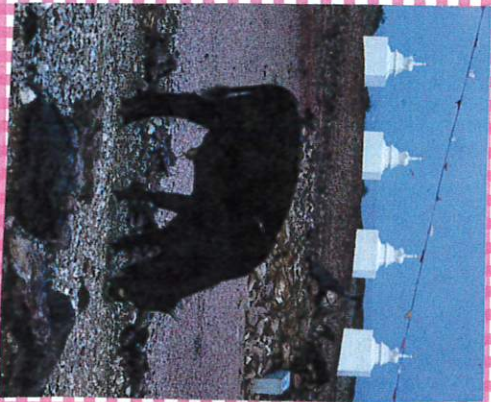

Our mission is to connect people in an organic and creative way to share meaningful art, comics, poetry, stories, and writing anonymously within our local community through zines.

So, what is a Zine?

Zine [zine] (zee-n) aka. - a self published, low circulation, non commercial publication of original or appropriated texts and art, usually reproduced via a copy machine. Often showcasing minority issues/interests LGBTQIA+, and other unique work often not found in large circulation print.

ZCPP meets every three weeks for two hours to cut and paste our zines together, and then we leave them around for people to find and read for free. This is a fantastic opportunity to connect with fellow students and get your voice heard!

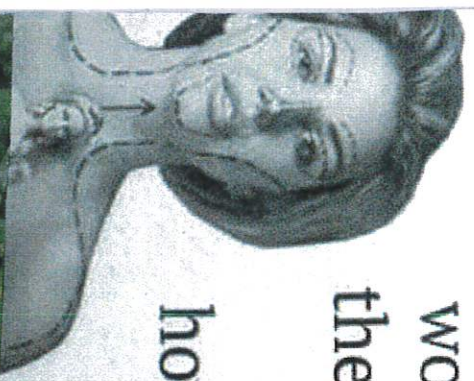
Submissions can be made regardless of if you are part of ZCPP or not, you can submit via our discord or through a student in the club. All submissions received for art and writing will be shared anonymously, this allows for faculty members here at college to also submit media they'd want to see shared. Similarly to a large newspaper or magazine publishing, ZCPP has a group of editors who finalize the submissions that make it into the next zine, gaining experience that could be useful for future careers in media and communications. However, just because your submission didn't make it into the most current zine, doesn't mean it won't get used, ZCPP may add it into a future edition where it flows or fits better.

ZCPP was started by a group of students in a journalism class discussion who just wanted to feel seen and heard, zines seemed like the best route to achieve this, as they offer a low budget way to share, come be a part of our quirky zine group, and let your voice be heard!

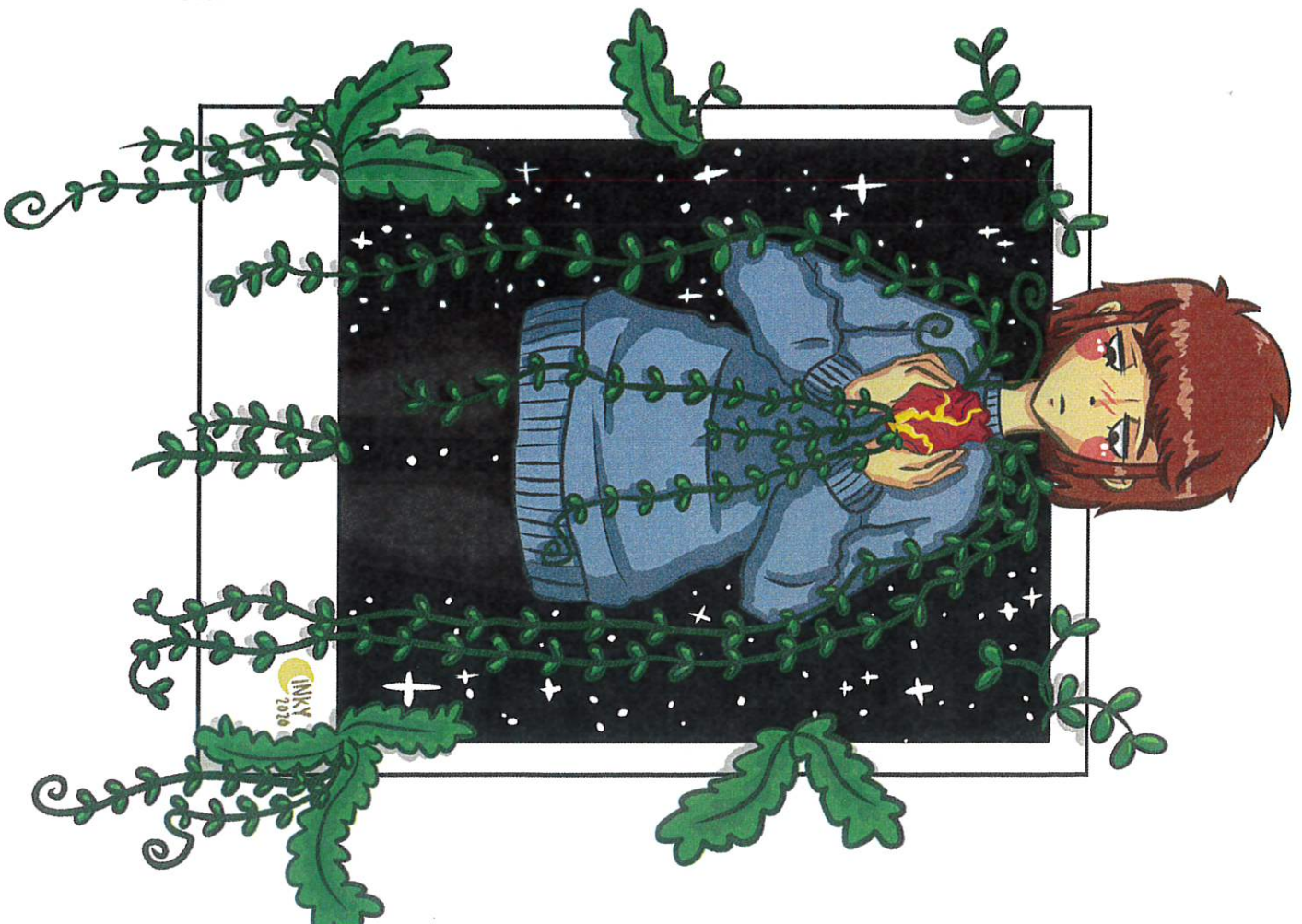
